GRAB BAG raced up close along the inside, dropped back a bit on the turn, split rivals to challenge in midstretch then edged clear in the final seventy yards. TRAVELATOR raced just off the early pace, rallied three wide to threaten in upper stretch, surged to the front in midstretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. MISS CAP broke inward at the start, raced well back to the turn then drifted out while rallying through the stretch. GLORIOUS MISS was bumped soundly the stumbled soon after the start, dueled along the rail into upper stretch and weakened. HASTA LA VISTA broke inward bumping with GLORIOUS MISS at the start, alternated for the lead from outside into midstretch and tired from her early efforts. HIDDEN RANSOM bobbled at the start, raced within striking distance while five wide for a half and lacked a strong closing bid. JENNY'S PRINCESS raced between rivals to the turn, angled five wide at the quarter pole then lacked a further response. SELF RISING steadied after being pinched back at the start and was never close thereafter. ANGELA'S LOVE never reached contention.
