CHANGING WORLD raced close up outside in hand, rallied three wide on the second turn, responded when roused and drew away under a drive. MYSTERY ITSELF was bumped after the start, raced wide throughout and rallied outside to get the place spot. MEADOW BELLE was bumped after the start, was hustled up inside, set the pace under constant pressure and tired in the final furlong. SOUNDS FISHY was roughed up after the start, was rated along early and had no response when roused. OUR ROYAL DANCER pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. BABY ANGEL was bumped at the start, raced close up inside and tired in the stretch. DOUBLE HALO raced three wide on the first turn, was four wide on the second turn and tired in the stretch. BUDAPEST GIRL was bounced around between rivals after the start, was pinched back, dropped back and lacked a rally. BROADWAY LADY was checked along the inside on the first turn, was steadied along the inside on the second turn and tired along the inside in the stretch.
