BEAU DARE sprinted clear early, opened a wide gap along the rail into upper stretch and drew off while being kept to the task. SWEET RANSOM bumped with ZAYNAB while in tight along the backstretch, split rivals at the quarter pole and finished willingly to best the others. EGYPT LANE angled in along the backstretch, steadied in traffic while saving ground on the turn and rallied mildly. ZAYNAB (FR) was bumped and shuffled back along the backstretch, steadied in traffic on the turn and failed to threaten thereafter. MY SISTER DIANE never reached contention while racing four wide throughout. SECRET BROOK steadied early and angled in causing crowding along the backstretch, raced up close for a half and gave way. OK TO PAY pressed the early pace from outside and drifted out while giving way on the turn.
