Footnotes

MR. VEGAS checked after breaking slowly, raced well back, was blocked in traffic on the turn, steadied while gaining at the three-sixteenths pole, checked in midstretch, split horses a sixteenth out and finished with a flourish to win going away. THUNDERING ROAR saved ground on the turn, moved between horses at the quarter pole, made a strong run while splitting horses to gain the lead inside the eighth pole then yielded grudgingly. SHRIMP DANCER stalked the pace five wide for a half, lodged a bid from outside in upper stretch, gained a brief lead in midstretch and yielded late. ALL ZIPPED UP raced well back to the turn, swung wide then rallied belatedly. SOLUTIONFINDERS checked after breaking awkwardly, circled five wide and closed late from outside. JOE D raced in midpack in traffic leaving the turn, swung four wide and finished evenly. LEATHERHEAD raced wide throughout. QUICK MONEY dueled in the two path into upper stretch and gave way. WANA PLAY dueled three wide between horses and faded on the turn. CONGA KING dueled heads apart on the rail to the top of the stretch and faltered.
