COUNT CATAMOUNT showed good speed and set the pace, controlled the tempo while inside on the turn, responded well when asked at the top of the stretch, came under a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, drifted out late and held under continued right hand urging. HOOLIGAN'S DELIGHT was fractious in the gate then forwardly placed down the backstretch, went three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, chased the winner determinedly in the final furlong but missed while well clear for the place. SAINTS ALIVE settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and earned the show while no match for the top two. WASCALLY RABBIT bumped with KINGSDALE OCEAN at the start, settled on the outside, dropped in leaving the backstretch, went three then two wide on the turn, came between rivals outside the quarter-pole, was asked for his best in upper stretch and failed to rally. FREE BRAVE was taken in hand while behind rivals early, moved to the inside, raced inside into the turn, lugged out a bit near the three-eighths pole, was guided with heavy use of the left rein, remained stuck near the back while inside into the stretch, came off the hedge shortly thereafter, was urged some while behind rivals, waited while

blocked from just outside the furlong marker to the sixteenth-pole, altered course to the outside and lost any chance at the minor awards in a tough trip. JET TO CLASSICS tracked the pace, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and came up empty. PEGASUS TOMMY D. was crowded at the start, raced under some urging very early then was taken in hand between rivals, came under urging while off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. ONE STARRY NITE was sent hard from the start then urged along at the back, raced inside into the turn, shifted three wide near the three-eighths pole, continued three wide into the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and was no factor. KINGSDALE OCEAN (IRE) bumped with WASCALLY RABBIT at the start, was urged some while on the outside, chased four then three wide on the turn and tired.
