

OFFICER PRADO broke inward slightly, was grabbed hold and immediately put back on a truer course, was hustled to engage MR. STYLE, argued for command, entrenched to that opponent's left side, stayed on nearly even terms, being the more slighter asked of the pair by the five-sixteenths pole, got set down to a drive as did the runner up turning for home, commencing the stretch run now placed in the two path, dug in with good determination, refusing to allow an equally determined foe to go by. MR. STYLE broke on top but was soon joined by the winner, sparred with that rival while racing along the outside, was forced to enter the stretch three wide after the top one gradually drifted into the two path by that point, fought gamely to the end, but was denied. SEVEN LIVELY SINS assumed a forward position soon after the start, was taken hold momentarily coming to the half mile, resumed the chase three wide departing the backstretch, but continued the run around the bend a bit closer to the inside, got asked for run at the five-sixteenths pole, failed to gain ground on the embattled twosome up ahead and had to settle for the show. BENOFEAR was a bit slow to settle into stride, angled sharply over towards the inside, tucking along the rail in the vicinity of the half mile pole, was under encouragement taking the inside route, improving position nearing the quarter pole, was under strong encouragement cutting the corner, maintained the momentum for an additional eighth before flattening out. FULL off the inside, chased the duel until the quarter pole before backing away. LURE OF THE SOUTH raced along the outside, failed to reach a contending position, reacting a bit greenly to an intermittent whip during the initial portion of the stretch run. LE GRAND ARTISTE got off a beat slowly, swerved out suddenly coming to the half mile pole, continued well off the inside thereafter, drifted very wide into upper stretch while tiring, was eased, then pulled up and walked off the track.
