MILDLY OFFENSIVE came away in good order, showed good natural speed, contested the pace on the outside, vied off the rail on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, inched clear near the three-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, was switched to a left-handed whip when threatened by KID KATE nearing the sixteenth-pole, drifted out a bit late and just held. KID KATE was urged along while last but one, went two then three wide on the turn, moved to four wide outside the quarter-pole, rallied under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, drifted in while gaining on the leader inside the furlong marker, loomed boldly on the outside but couldn't get by and settled for the place. DANCINGINHERDREAMS settled at the back of the field, raced inside early on the turn, was asked nearing the five-sixteenths pole, angled three wide shortly thereafter, came under a right-handed whip coming to the quarter-pole, continued under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, moved out some when switched to a left-handed whip near the furlong marker, went back to a right-handed whip shortly thereafter and finished with good energy to garner the show. STRIKE THE MOON was urged along while just off the pace, moved closer outside the half-mile pole, chased while off the rail on the turn, raced behind MILDLY OFFENSIVE turning into the stretch, came under the whip near the three-sixteenths pole, pursued the aforementioned rival into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. TIZ THE ARGUMENT was urged along while just off the pace, moved closer outside the half-mile pole, dropped back in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, raced near the inside on the turn and came up empty. MOONLIT MALIBU was hustled from the start, disputed the pace on the inside of the winner, chased that rival in upper stretch and gave way. TAMARIND HALL showed early speed on the outside, allowed the pacesetting duo to go on with it, tracked those opponents on the outside, chased three to four wide on the turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and tired.
