**Footnotes**

SUSTAINED took the inside route around the opening bend, remained unhurried two wide down the backstretch, advanced steadily into contention during the run around the far turn, being asked for run all the while, fanned outward once into the stretch, leaving the three-sixteenths pole four wide under strong handling, forged onward to grab away the lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and drew clear. MANUKA HONEY established control soon after the start and was guided over to the inside, cut the pace being rated on a loosely-contested lead and did so for just over three-quarters, was put to encouragement after turning for home, felt the winner's presence with about a furlong to go, relinquished a sixteenth later, then just dug in long enough to salvage second. SENSATIONALIZE well reserved for the initial six furlongs, picked up the pace approaching the quarter pole, was already under urging spinning five wide into upper stretch, finished with strong late energy, just failing to secure second. HITECHNOWEENIE saved ground and held well. EAR D' RHYTHM loped along from the near the inside, was angled slightly outward in midstretch, mustered up a mild response. SMITTENWITHKITTEN lacked the necessary stretch response. NEITH tracked inside and faltered. GIANT'S JEWEL was placed into the two path at the half mile pole, folded. DOUBLE TAPPED stalked the pacesetter without applying any serious pressure, tired. SCEALEILE three wide on the far turn, tired abruptly coming to the five-sixteenths pole.
