TALAVERA, bumped at the start and rated three wide, rallied four wide and finished well to earn the place. CRAFTY MAN raced wide throughout and had no response when roused. SOVEREIGN M. D., bumped at the start, pressed the pace while between rivals and tired. DANCE THE BALLADO, rated on the rail, raced inside and tired badly.
