SPECTACULAIREONTAP was rated along early, rallied four wide on the second turn, dug in gamely through the stretch and was clear under the line, driving. RICHIE'S GIRLS quickly showed in front, set the pace and stayed on gamely through the stretch. LADY D'JOUR raced with the pace from the outside and weakened in the final furlong. SMOOTH BLUES was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. BID'S FEMME had no response when roused. VANGELIA chased three wide and tired in the stretch. BRANDALA raced close up inside and had no rally. ESCORP had no rally. RED TEES was outrun. PRECEDENCE raced wide and tired.
