BOWMAN'S BAND raced within striking distance while in hand early, advanced inside approaching the stretch, angled out for the drive, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. AMJAAD was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside to get the place award. HOLIDAY THUNDER was hustled up inside, contested the pace and continued on well along the rail. PERSONABLE PETE raced close up outside, put in a four wide run approaching the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. TOMBSTONE (ARG) raced close up inside, angled out for the drive and had no rally. STONE AGE contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. LONE RANGER broke awkwardly and was outrun. YOU ARE IN CONTROL contested the pace while three wide and tired.
