Footnotes

PROUD ACCOLADE stalked the pace from outside for a half, made a run to challenge at the quarter pole, took charge under right hand urging in upper stretch then drew off through the final eighth. STORM CREEK RISING outsprinted rivals for the early advantage, set the pace under pressure to the top of the stretch, relinquished the lead to the winner in upper stretch and held well for the place. CALYPSO BAND settled just off the early pace, raced in traffic between horses on the turn, swung five wide for room entering the stretch then finished willingly to gain a share. ROYAL MOMENT pressed the pace along the rail to the turn and weakened. FIRE PATH raced within striking distance while four wide for a half and lacked a strong closing response. CRIMSON STAG steadied along the rail on the far turn, swung five wide nearing the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. IT'S BREAK TIME ducked out at the start and was never close thereafter.
