**Footnotes**

LAWYER RON was taken in hand and altered course to the outside of WANDERIN BOY midway on the first turn, stalked the pace in the three to four path along the backstretch, moved to the front from outside leaving the far turn, took charge approaching the stretch, quickly opened a commanding lead in upper stretch then drew off with authority under a vigorous hand ride. SUN KING steadied along the inside while being taken back on the first turn, trailed for five furlongs while saving ground along the backstretch, angled to the two path while gaining midway on the turn, split rivals leaving the quarter pole then closed late between horses to best the others. DIAMOND STRIPES steadied briefly along the inside while saving ground on the first turn, raced in good position just behind the leaders in the two path along the backstretch, launched a bid along the inside leaving the turn and lacked a strong closing response. CORINTHIAN was unhurried while three wide along the backstretch, rapidly closed the gap leaving the far turn, made a three wide move between horses to threaten briefly on the turn and came up empty on the stretch. POLITICAL FORCE was rated in midpack while three wide for six furlongs, gained a bit from outside on the turn, checked slightly when SUN KING split horses at the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. BRASS HAT trailed early after breaking a bit slowly, raced well back while five wide to the turn and lacked the needed response when called upon. WANDERIN BOY set the pace along the inside to the far turn and gave way. MAGNA GRADUATE raced up close early while four wide, continued wide along the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and was never close thereafter.
