Footnotes

BARTLETTS pressed the pace three wide for nearing six furlongs, surged to the front midway on the turn, dug in when challenged in midstretch, battled along the inside into deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. COUNTERSPY stalked three wide along the backstretch, closed the gap from outside on the turn, drew on even terms with the winner a furlong out, fought heads apart through the final sixteenth and lost the bob. D' WILDCARD tucked in along the rail, saved ground to the turn, angled out entering the stretch then closed steadily from outside to narrowly gain a share. KAPTAIN saved ground for five furlongs, split rivals on the turn, gained in upper stretch and rallied mildly. VORENUS broke slowly, was outrun for five furlongs, gained inside leaving the turn and finished well between horses. REPENTHOUSE saved ground to no avail. PUT HIM BACK raced up close along the rail to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. ALL THE WAY HOME checked at the start, stalked our wide for five furlongs, dropped back on the turn and faded in the stretch. LOOK NOW was never a factor while wide throughout. APTUS set the pace in hard to the turn and gave way.
