REGAL RANSOM off alertly, powered by the field under his own courage to establish command well before reaching the opening bend, was firmly rated and well off the inside carving out the pace, remained on hold as COOL COAL MAN geared up to make his challenge midway around the second turn, waited until that one drew abreast at the quarter pole before being asked for a response, successfully turned back that foe's challenge during the ensuing furlong, proceeded to draw off to a sizeable margin before being taken well in hand leaving the sixteenth pole. COOL COAL MAN broke on top, yet readily conceded the early advantage to REGAL RANSOM, jumped over that one's heels as he was maneuvered to the top one's outside leaving the first turn, patiently played the role of stalker, perched just off the leader's hind quarters, was called upon for run soon after entering the far turn, in preparation for his challenge, gradually ranged up, reaching nearly even terms by the quarter pole, continued the chase, proved no match, but came home willingly to be clearly second best. ATONED reserved taking the inside route, swung into action by angling three wide into the lane, rallied well enough to be along for the show. DISCREET TREASURE was bumped while wedged between rivals upon reaching the first turn, sat within range from the outside, and tired. BAD ACTION with intentions of being guided over to the rail coming to the first turn, had the rider take a peek towards his left side, but was initially denied by ATONED, came out a bit, tightening up things and instigating a string of bumps involving himself as well as DISCREET TREASURE and TIMBER RESERVE, ducked to the inside once sufficiently clear, late on the opening bend, advanced into contention from the midway point on the backstretch, remained within good striking distance until the head of the stretch before backing off. TIMBER RESERVE bumped early on the first turn, raced wide, was pulled up on the backstretch and subsequently vanned off.
