### Footnotes

DEVILISH DUE took up position just off the inside, and well placed off the speed duel developing up front, remained unhurried for nearly a half, found ample room to maneuver three wide prior to challenging the pace battlers, responded positively when given his cue after being straightened away, reached even terms by the eighth pole, needed several additional strides to forge to the front, then edged clear while being kept busy. END OF THE GULCH away well from the gate, disputed the pace from the two path, continued to match strides with TALK TO NICK during the run around the bend, shook free off that one, only to be put to the test by the top one, clung to narrowest of leads upon reaching the furlong marker, offered resistance for a few more strides, before yielding reluctantly, then displayed good determination to stave off MEL'S GOLD and preserve second. MEL'S GOLD broke on top, but was outsprinted for the early lead, underwent a three wide pursuit, was forced to take the four path into the lane, when DEVILISH DUE made his move into the stretch, then rallied mildly to take the show. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC hit the right of the gate, raced four wide around the turn, and finished willingly down the outside of the strip to grab the last major share. FAIRWAY TOM under a firm hold, rode the rail, advanced into a good striking position as the field neared the head of the stretch, angled outward to resume the bid, maintained position under mild hand urging, while lacking optimal clearance until the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, found the needed room by then, but failed to fire once called upon. RUN TO GRAND AVE. entered the turn from the four path, before working his way a couple of paths closer to the inside by midpoint, was asked for a response turning for home, but came up empty. TALK TO NICK went on to assume a forward spot after bobbling at the break, dueled with the runner up while racing along the rail, gave way leaving the furlong grounds.
