Footnotes

SELF CONTROL took up a forward position along the inside, was lightly coaxed along tracking a pace dispute, crept up towards the embattled pair departing the backstretch, and was forced to sit on hold, stymied just off heels from the five-sixteenths pole until midstretch, was eased outward shortly after turning for home, tipped to the outside a bit more as an opening between the front runners was developing, squeezed through when large enough, in the vicinity of the eighth pole, gained readily and took over the lead with about a sixteenth to go, edged away, under good handling. PIQUANT three wide entering the turn, was four wide leaving it, got put to a prolonged drive and displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to garner place honors. TROILUS raced three wide on the turn, kept pace with the front runners under encouragement during the run around the bend, took off in earnest angling three wide into the stretch, remained a prominent factor for an additional eighth, before flattening out. PISCESBYMOONLIGHT hand urged from the gate, moved up with willingness to engage EASTSIDE TRAIN for command, went at it head to head with that opponent until upper stretch, edged clear but approached the furlong marker with fresher foes bearing down hard, held his ground for a little while, succumbed at the sixteenth pole and steadily weakened thereafter. EASTSIDE TRAIN broke on top, but was soon joined by PISCESBYMOONLIGHT, got engaged in a spirited tussle with that foe, battling away from the two path, kept up the fight with good energy before backing away in upper stretch. FAIR WHIT off the inside, was put to strong encouragement leaving the half mile pole, failed to make any headway on the front runners. VOLITION between rivals for a good portion of the run down the backstretch, was through after completing a half.
