HARBOR MIST showed good speed, controlled the tempo through the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, extended the advantage in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and maintained a safe advantage under steady urging. WHY TAKE A CHANCE settled on the outside, moved in leaving the backstretch, was urged along while near the inside on the turn, moved out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip inside the furlong marker and finished willingly for the place. VICTORY ISLAND stumbled at the start and was last away, was asked then shifted to the outside, advanced while urged along, chased three wide on the turn, came under the whip nearing the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. PURE GOSSIP settled just off the pace while off the inside, dropped back some early on the turn, was asked near the three-eighths pole, swung four wide into the stretch, drifted in slightly near the three-sixteenths pole and also lacked the needed response. BELLACOURT was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the turn and tired. HOOK IT UP tracked the pace on the outside, chased on the turn, was in tight while tiring at the top of the stretch and gave way.
