ARCH SUPPORT off to a good beginning, quickly settled into a forward position, patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside under a snug hold until the half mile pole, was let out a notch and crept up towards that opponent, drawing alongside late on the far turn, bided time for just a while longer, got called upon and bid in earnest turning for home, fought her way to a narrow edge during the ensuing furlong, and remained well clear to the end, driving. HUMADEA (GB) sat reserved in midpack along the outside until nearing the quarter pole, swung into the lane and got called upon, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch run, altered course outward approaching the furlong marker, and picked up speed after completing the maneuver, split rivals a sixteenth down the road and flashed good late foot en route for the place. UP IN LIGHTS contently lagged behind at the rear of the pack along the outside until the half mile pole, picked up interest upon entering the far turn, was placed three wide at the five-sixteenths pole in preparation for the stretch drive, spun into the lane one path wider, came home with good energy to take the show. STAR TORINA appeared eager for the front, had the rider apply a strong grip on the reins as she established control, tucked over to the inside prior to the opening bend, rating very kindly by now, cut the pace, with the top one making her presence felt along the outside, had that opponent increase the pressure nearing the five-sixteenths pole, remained on hold before being asked for a response nearing the top of the stretch, offered some resistance before relinquishing, weakened during the last eighth. SEX APPEAL sat reserved along the inside, was eased outward and placed five wide at the head of the stretch, rallied mildly to improve position. GREAT GRACIE DANE saved ground to no avail. LOURE tracked the pacesetter from the inside, left the pocket in the vicinity of the quarter pole, flattened out departing the furlong grounds. NORTHERN COAST three wide around both turns, folded.
