BERGERAC went three wide on the initial turn, prompted the pace on the outside, drew even late on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled on the outside of J. B.'S THUNDER, inched clear into the final furlong and held sway under left hand urging. UNACCOUNTABLE was taken in hand early, raced inside on the first turn, dropped back early on the backstretch, was reserved off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, raced under urging in upper stretch, moved out while gaining near the sixteenth-pole and closed well but was too late. GRAND CASH raced off the hedge on the first turn, settled towards the inside, advanced while saving ground and urged along on the far turn, came off the inside in upper stretch, loomed a threat coming to the eighth-pole, chased the winner in the final furlong and finished willingly but missed the place. J. B.'S THUNDER went to the early lead, raced off the inside on the first turn, set the pace through moderate fractions, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong then tired. BREAK UP THE GAME angled in before the first turn, saved ground on that turn, lingered well back in the field, came under some urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, found his best stride in the final furlong and finished with good late energy. CAPITAL MARKET went three wide on the first turn, was rated under a hold, moved closer on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. PRADO DASH went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, moved out a bit near the three-sixteenths pole and also lacked the needed response. XODO lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on both turns and failed to menace while gaining some ground. LETHAL COMBINATION moved in before the first turn, raced off the rail on that turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch

and failed to rally.
