NEATIE THE CAT grabbed the advantage soon after the start and was sent over to the rail, showed the way from there feeling some pressure all the while, got roused entering the stretch, dug in well enough long enough under a drive to hold on. WESTERN TRYST underwent a three wide pursuit, commenced the stretch run slightly wider, finished with good energy, missed. PETEY CRAMER tracked the pacesetter from the pocket, continued on willingly down the stretch for the show. COUNTKNICKERBOCKER three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, spun five wide into the stretch, got straightened away and gained steadily in the final furlong en route for the last major check. NEXT QUESTION checked while in tight quarters for several strides proceeding down the backstretch, reached the turn no longer in that predicament and gave chase from the two path, raced while stuck in traffic from upper stretch to the end, idling under a good hold from the pilot for nearly the entire last eighth. SLEEPY FREUD got hustled into midpack, raced from between rivals on the turn, had no rally. HOOLIGAN'S DELIGHT pressed the issue from the three path, needed some urging by the five-sixteenths pole to keep pace, tired. ALL CLASS

brushed with HOOKDONCHURCHPUNCH after stumbling at the break, saved ground and went on to improve position. ADJOURNMENT forwardly placed in the early going, was steadied before reaching the end of the backstretch, losing significant ground and momentum, tucked over to the rail on the turn and failed to reach a contending position again. RUDY RUDY RUDY stumbled at the start, yet managed to get away alertly, contested the pace from the two path until upper stretch before backing away. HOOKDONCHURCHPUNCH made light contact with ALL CLASS at the start, faded off the subsequent ground-saving journey. STYLISH FELLA raced along the outside and trailed.
