DOMINUS broke in at the start bumping QUEEN'SPLATEKITTEN mildly, was well rated on the pace just off the inside in the two path, maneuvered to the rail at the seven-sixteenths remaining on hold until the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch at that station let out, edged away to a safe margin with a furlong to go, saw that margin cut into a bit late on while kept to task to the wire to prevail. DATA LINK just off the pace initially in the two path, came under light coaxing shifting out to the three path at the three-eighths pole, was set down in earnest cornering for home, offered up a good kick willingly, cut into the leader's margin too late while safely garnering the place. SKY BLAZER leapt at the break getting off slow as a result conceding about five to six lengths to the front, crossed to the inside shortly after the start, shifted back out down the backside to the three path before again angling inside into the far turn while racing at the rear, got spirited up at the quarter pole, angled out to the four path nearing the eighth pole, kicked on with good energy to garner the show honors while never threatening the top. GUYS REWARD in close range just off the inside from the two path, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths, continued the long drive into the stretch, offered up a mild kick through to the final sixteenth before being outfinished late on while beginning to weaken in the late stages. QUEEN'SPLATEKITTEN bumped at the start when DOMINUS broke outwards, raced two to three deep in midpack, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, shifted four wide at the three-eighths as DATA LINK angled out in front while clear, got out kicked through the stretch while displaying belated energy in the late stages to close some ground while making no impact. PRINCE WILL I AM towards the rear saving ground, was roused into the lane swinging two to three wide, kicked home making mild late headway through the lane while never threatening.
