### Footnotes

GOLDEN RULE was ridden along while off the pace, moved out near the half-mile pole, advanced four to five wide on the turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, edged clear in upper stretch and drew away while ridden out. DARNLEY BAY showed speed then pressed between rivals, moved out while chasing on the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. MEDIUM OF EXCHANGE pressed the pace between rivals, dropped back while behind the pacesetter leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn and weakened while able to get the show. MALIBU QUEEN broke out at the start, chased the pace between horses, took the lead with a half-mile to run, vied three then two wide on the turn, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and tired. CEBU was urged along while well back in the field, raced off the rail early on the turn then shifted four wide and failed to threaten. GINGEE was void of speed, went mostly two to three wide on the turn and was no factor. WORK N FLIRT veered out at the start, was forwardly placed on the outside, made a bid near the half-mile pole, vied four then three wide on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and faltered. WEDDING LASS chased the pace between horses, dropped back near the half-mile pole, lugged out a bit while four to five wide on the turn and stopped. SUZENSHINE was hustled to the lead, set the pace under pressure, lost the advantage at the half-mile pole, came up empty on the turn and retreated.
