HAMNET strung out three wide on the opening bend, was just as wide around the subsequent one, picked up interest when asked for run leaving the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home under strong encouragement and with good momentum, forged his way to the front to lead by a head with a furlong remaining, getting there only a whisker ahead of another twosome battling hard to her inside, had the middle member drop out of the fight about a sixteenth down the road, dueled with the runner up the rest of the way to the end and gamely proved best. OUR EMERALD FOREST (IRE) secured a forward position after the start, contently tracked the front runners for the opening three-quarters, was given his cue entering the stretch and responded positively, drew up to MIO D'ORO as did the winner to challenge in earnest nearing the furlong marker, continued the battle one on one with the top one from the sixteenth pole onward, fought with vigor but couldn't go by. RELENTLESS RIDE lunged outward, bumping with STANDUP PADDLE, took the three path around the first turn, steadily worked his way towards the inside thereafter, eventually winding up on the rail on the second bend, cut the corner into the lane, with TAPIT QUICK following suit a short distance behind, was maneuvered to be outside the front runners departing the eighth pole, finished fairly evenly after completing it. MIO D'ORO away without mishap, quickly established control, sat positioned at or very near the two path being rated along on a loosely-contested lead, led the field into the stretch with none latched on and was set down, arrived at the eighth pole, vying vigorously inside another duo, appeared to weakening slightly when gently pinched back a sixteenth later. TAPIT QUICK stumbled awkwardly at the start with the field having been sent on its way almost immediately after the last rival had been loaded into her stall, was quickly tucked along the rail and rode it until the very late stages, cut the corner into the stretch right behind RELENTLESS RIDE had done so, settled into her best stride once past the furlong grounds, flashing solid belated energy en route to minor spoils. WAR CLASSIC pressed the issue three wide and gave way. BROTHER BRENDAN along the inside during the initial stages, swung six wide into upper stretch, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. IRON WORKS chased from the two path and tired. FRAME sputtered four wide heading to the first turn, departed it from the thee path and angled closer to the rail soon afterwards, sat in midpack two wide on the far turn, was asked for run and got fanned five wide for the start of the stretch, had no rally. STANDUP PADDLE bumped at the start, raced along the outside and was no factor.
