Footnotes

SHMOOZ TALKER prompted the pace on the inside, dropped back a bit near the seven-sixteenths pole, drafted behind leader while along the hedge on the turn, turned into the stretch directly behind the pacesetter, was asked near the three-sixteenths, was presented with an opening when JAGATI drifted out a few paths, rallied under a right-handed whip to make a bid at the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and powered clear under strong urging. ISN'TLOVEJUSTGRAND was restless in the gate, came away in good order, moved in while off the pace, bided his time while off the rail on the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, was given his cue while moving out some, drifted out near the eighth-pole, came under a right-handed whip and finished willingly for the place. JAGATI was hustled from the start, set the pace through tepid fractions, vied a bit off the hedge on the turn, drifted out some in upper stretch which allowed the winner through, lost the advantage inside the furlong marker and proved no match then was caught for the place. PRECIOUS METAL settled on the outside, moved in near the seven-sixteenths, went three wide while coaxed along on the turn, shifted five wide at the quarter-pole, came under a drive while on the outside and failed to rally. LUIGI P settled towards the rear, raced inside on the turn, came off the rail

while asked at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten while drifting out late. WAR HITCH was last away, settled near the back while off the hedge, was asked while shifting three wide into the stretch, came under the whip and was no factor. SYNTHESIZER chased the pace on the outside, raced two to three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and tired. VICTORIOUS LEADER was coaxed along while just off the pace, went three to four wide on the turn, faltered in upper stretch and was eased in the final furlong then vanned off after crossing the wire.
