Footnotes

SATURDAY NTHE PARK was asked from the start, dropped in some while ridden along off the pace, shifted out outside the half-mile pole, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, swept to the front on the outside, came under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker and proved best under steady handling. AL'S ROSIE settled near the back while under some urging, dropped in with a half-mile to run, was ridden along while off the rail on the turn, rallied into contention in upper stretch, chased under a right-handed whip into the final furlong and was outkicked while well clear for the place. STELLERITE contested the pace on the inside of a rival, dropped back near the half-mile pole, raced inside early on the turn, angled three wide outside the five-sixteenths, made a bid while four wide into the stretch, dropped back while under a left-handed whip and tired while best of the rest. TIME ON MY HANDS disputed the pace on the outside, moved clear with a half-mile to run, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead before the three-sixteenths and gave way. FARCE was hard ridden while off the pace, moved out some midway down the backstretch, dropped back in to save ground on the turn and failed to threaten. IMPLIED was ridden along while off the pace, drifted out some midway down the backstretch, went four to five wide on the turn and faltered.
