FIVE IRON established the front from the start in hand just off the hedge, remained patiently handled settling in a rhythm down the backside, had the rider sneak a peek back nearing the three-eighths pole, got let out a notch just past the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home roused under cross reined encouragement, drifted out a path and was corrected under off sided stick work, held well drifting out again under cross reined encouragement in the final sixteenth safely clear to the wire. NOTACATBUTALLAMA tucked into the two path shortly after the start unhurried early on towards the rear, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths to advance on the hedge from midway on the turn into prominence nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide into upper stretch let out for the drive, shifted out a path at the three-sixteenths as FIVE IRON drifted out a path albeit safely in front, rallied with good energy through the stretch, proved unable to reel in the top one while chasing the winner home safe for the place. JOHA tracked the front just off the inside in range, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths to take closer order on the front, got asked at the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside into the stretch and kept on mildly for the show clear of the rest. TATTENHAM towards the rear two to three wide, came under urging three wide three furlongs out, angled four wide for home and made no late headway. FRONT four wide into the first turn under a light grip, came under coaxing down the backside while in range of the leader, got ridden along from the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. FAVOR FACTOR a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, broke in at the break brushing the near side stall and bumping mildly with FRAC DADDY, settled three wide towards the rear, got asked four wide at the five-sixteenths and made no impact. FRAC DADDY broke out at the start trading bumps with FAVOR FACTOR, raced three wide through the first turn, got coaxed along within aim of the front, shifted in a path at the seven-sixteenths, began to fade between foes at the three-eighths, continued the retreat in the latter portion of the turn and tired.
