BRAHMS was rated along inside, altered course to the outside in upper stretch, responded when roused and was clear under the wire, driving. QUIET QUEST contested the pace along the inside and stayed on gamely to the finish. RIVER BED was rated along outside, rallied four wide on the second turn and finished gamely outside. POLISH TIMES raced close up while between rivals and stayed on gamely through the stretch. KOLINOR raced close up inside while well in hand and had no rally. SLEWFRITO chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. EL TEMPERAMENTAL contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. HEAVENLY SHOW was steadied along the inside on the first turn and had no rally. SECRET FRIEND (CHI) had no response when roused. COMMANCHE SADDLE (IRE) broke slowly and raced inside.
