SPEED TO BURN contested the pace while three wide, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. CHASE GAP raced close up inside early, came wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. UNSURPASSED broke slowly, was bothered after the start, rallied wide into the stretch and finished well outside. ALY QUATORZE was hustled along early, raced wide and finished well outside. AS TOLD chased the pace while four wide and weakened in the final furlong. TIME FOR A LADY contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. ROYAL LASSIE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. DOWNSIDE RISK raced inside and tired in the stretch. SHOP GIRL contested the pace along the inside, was taken up entering the stretch and tired. DIAMOND POINT broke slowly and was outrun.
