Footnotes

IRISH SMOKE was in hand early, raced in good position while saving ground, angled out in traffic on the turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, took charge in midstretch and drew away under steady right hand urging. A TO THE CROFT was outrun to the turn, swung four wide to launch her bid at the quarter pole, altered course wide in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. YONAGUCCI hit the side of the gate and broke in the air, was outrun for a half, circled five wide into the stretch and finished willingly. MORAKAMI saved ground while gaining on the turn, made a run to reach contention in upper stretch and finished evenly. MORE HAPPY set the pace inside, opened a wide gap on the turn and gave way in the stretch. BLITZING bumped at the start, stalked four wide for five furlongs and drifted out while tiring in the stretch. PHANTOM INCOME raced up close between horses to the turn and gave way. SALTY WAVE was outrun early, rallied along the rail on the turn and flattened out. PASSION bumped with BLITZING at the start, chased four wide for five furlongs and gave way.
