BONAVENTO pressed the pace three wide, duelled heads apart into deep stretch and prevailed under right hand urging. FAYOUM set the pace under pressure the entire way and yielded grudgingly. CHIEF COUNSEL was reserved early, rallied four wide leaving the turn then finished well to gain a share. REIN KING pressed the leaders along the rail into midstretch and weakened late. BAATESH stalked three wide into upper stretch and lacked a late response. BROTHER STUART failed to mount a serious rally while five wide. ROYAL STOCKS checked after being bumped at the start, saved ground to the turn, drifted wide while racing greenly at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. ROULETTE WINNER was outrun along the rail. SWASHBUCKLER checked after breaking awkwardly, swung five wide at the quarter pole, angled to the inside in upper stretch and failed to menace.
