SUCCESS FEE was outrun for a half, circled five wide and unleashed a strong late run to win going away. KATSKILL BAY raced well back, checked in traffic on the turn, rapidly gain in upper stretch and finished well to best the others. ZIPTRONIC dueled on the rail, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and weakened late. C T CHIMES raced in traffic along the rail on the turn and rallied mildly. MR. BOURBON STREET lodged a five wide move on the turn and flattened out. THAT'S RICH raced evenly while three wide. DIXIELAND STAR raced up close along the rail to the turn and tired. LOOKIN AT HER pressed the pace between horses and gave way in upper stretch. RAFFIE'S DEER checked at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. CLIENT EIGHT dueled outside for a half and tired. OLYMPIC PEGASUS failed to menace.
