Footnotes

THERESMYEVERYTHING was reserved while a bit eager in the early going, raced inside on the first turn, moved out near the three-quarter pole, settled on the backstretch, steadied slightly behind rivals near the three-eighths pole, shifted three wide shortly thereafter and was asked for run, rallied while still three wide into the stretch, closed well under hand urging to get the lead passing the furlong marker, was given one crack of a left-handed whip to keep his mind on business and drew away under mild hand urging. RUDY RUDY RUDY went to the early lead, was well rated while setting the pace along the hedge, came under some urging approaching the quarter-pole, was set down in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while clearly second best. MAZARA DEL VALLO settled on the inside, came a bit off the hedge on the backstretch, raced inside early on the far turn, came off the hedge near the five-sixteenths pole, swung three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. FREUD'S DEBUT was reserved towards the rear of the field while on the inside, came off the hedge near the three-eighths pole, dropped back to the inside nearing the quarter-pole, angled out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and improved position. LOCAL LEGACY stalked the leader on the outside, was asked to pursue that rival early on the far turn, chased into the stretch and weakened. COUPON was bit rank in the early going, raced three wide into the first turn, was tucked into the two path shortly thereafter, became very rank while hard held, continued rank while still under restraint on the backstretch, was given free rein approaching the five-sixteenths pole, chased inside into the stretch and came up empty. CARD UP HIS SLEEVE settled well off the pace, raced

two to three wide on the turns and failed to threaten. HAYA'S BOY was off slow, went two to three wide on the first turn, lingered near the back of the field, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and was no factor. COUSIN FRANKIE was reserved while off the hedge, settled in the front half of the field on the backstretch, came up empty while urged along on the far turn and faded. BIGGER IS BETTOR was off slow, dropped well behind the field, saved ground on the turns and trailed. (Rail at Hedge)
