Footnotes

PEARLY BLUE raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was near the hedge on the second turn, continued outside on the backstretch, advanced into contention while four wide on the far turn, rallied when put to a drive outside the furlong marker, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. DYANI lagged at the rear of the field while unhurried, was urged while two to three wide on the final turn, shifted out while still well behind in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and finished well but was too late. EMERALD BEECH was taken in hand after the start, threw her head while very resistant of the rating tactics, set the pace while hard to rate, was asked to pick it up near the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when set down in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was collared and weakened late then held the show. FANCY FIONA settled in the middle of the field while off the hedge, continued off the inside while under some urging on the final turn, came under stronger urging in upper stretch, moved between rivals near the furlong marker, dropped to the inside shortly thereafter and lacked the needed kick. MUHAAWARA tracked the solo leader on the outside, chased that rival on the final turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but also lacked the needed kick. SWEET TUNE was reserved inside through the first two turns, moved out some on the backstretch, went three wide on the final turn, was roused near the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch, gained ground into the final furlong but lacked the needed response thereafter. LOST AT DAWN was reserved on the inside, came under some urging with a half-mile to run, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally. DANCE PASS (IRE) raced three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the hedge, settled towards the front, was urged along while three wide on the final turn and came up empty. (Rail at Hedge)
