Footnotes

ROYAL BONNIE stalked the leader on the outside, engaged that rival on the far turn, was set down in upper stretch, drifted out a bit under left hand urging nearing the furlong marker, battled with PROUD AND CHARMING, was switched to a right-handed whip and proved best under good handling. PROUD AND CHARMING was bumped soundly at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, steadied to avoid LANDLUBBER outside the half-mile pole, swerved to the outside, regained momentum shortly thereafter, chased three to four wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled on the outside of the winner, drifted out a bit late and missed. STOCK FUND was rank while under a hold on the first turn, settled just off the pace while inside on the backstretch, moved up near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced just off heels briefly, bided her time on the far turn, came off the hedge approaching the quarter-pole, was put to a strong right-handed drive in upper stretch, moved in near the furlong marker and finished willingly for the show. HLAO ROO dropped well back in the field, steadied outside the half-mile pole then swerved to the outside, dropped back in nearing the far turn, remained towards the back through the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and improved position. LADYWELL COURT went three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, checked to avoid LANDLUBBER outside the half-mile pole, swerved to the outside, went four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. DESERT BLISS angled in before the first turn, dropped to the inside by late on that turn, settled well off the pace, was roused while two then three wide on the far turn and also failed to rally. SKINNYDIPPER bumped with a rival after the start, lagged well back in the field, went three wide on the far turn and

failed to threaten. WHO'S ZAT GIRL angled in early, settled nicely off the pace, was urged while off the inside on the far turn and came up empty. ARIZONA TAMMY bobbed at the start then was bumped in the hindquarters, settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and failed to respond. JOY RISING went to the early lead, set the pace while a bit hard to rate, lost the lead outside the quarter-pole and gave way. LANDLUBBER bumped with a rival after the start, settled towards the front of the field, went wrong outside the half-mile pole and was pulled up then vanned off.
