**Footnotes**

ELUSIVE PEARL stalked the leader on the outside, engaged that rival on the far turn, kicked clear when set down in upper stretch and maintained a safe advantage under steady urging. RUTHENIA angled in at the back of the field, was reserved at the rear, saved ground on the far turn, angled out inside the quarter-pole, was put to a drive on the far outside and finished with good energy for the place. DIVALARIOUS was well placed while off the inside, raced between rivals on the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, came under a drive and finished willingly for the show. STARFORMER was bumped near the neck region after the start, took an awkward stride, was reserved while on the inside, waited while buried along the rail on the far turn, steadied while blocked in upper stretch, found room inside the three-sixteenths pole then finished willingly but failed to recover from the trouble. NIJI'S GRAND GIRL saved ground on the first turn, brushed with INDIAN POND early on the backstretch, moved up with five-furlongs to run, drafted behind the leaders while inside on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, came off the inside and also lacked the needed response. PUZZLING settled on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. DECENNIAL was rank while three wide on the first turn, raced on the outside while under some restraint, went three wide on the far turn and weakened. INDIAN POND was reserved while off the pace, raced between rivals on the far turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole and also failed to rally. MY LOST SILVER bumped STARFORMER with

her hindquarters after the start, set the pace along the hedge through moderate fractions, was challenged on the far turn, vied into the stretch and gave way.
