Footnotes

NATIVE WAVE settled into the middle of the pack, raced from off the rail under a good hold from the pilot, tucked along the rail past the half mile pole and rode it during the run around the far turn, drafted behind ESPIRITU LIBRE angling two wide into the stretch, waited until the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole to tip out one additional path before commencing his rally in earnest, was barely behind the two front runners arriving at the eighth pole, hooked up a spirited tussle with the runner up from that station all the way to the wire, raced heads apart throughout it all, gamely got the head down in time when it counted to prove best. ESPIRITU LIBRE patiently tracked the loose leader while taking the inside route, rated until the quarter pole, angled into the two path for the start of the stretch drive, with the eventual winner following his cover for entrance into lane, dueled on nearly even terms with that opponent for the final furlong, was game to the end, but lost the bob. FORT BOONESBOROUGH saved ground until midstretch, got outfinished by the top twosome. RELENTLESS ROAD left the starting gate full of run, was given enough free rein rather than have the rider attempt to throttle down the early eagerness and sped off to her lonesome self, set swift splits on an uncontested lead, felt pressure for the initial time approaching the quarter pole and was soon let out, was still in front by the narrowest of margins at the eighth pole, but with the first two finishers poised to roll by which both did a couple of jumps later, weakened steadily thereafter. BARRYMORE off the inside, was put to encouragement angling three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. TWIGAZURI STRAIT three wide around both turns, had no rally. SATURNUS stalked from afar in the two path, came up empty when asked for a response at the five-sixteenths marker. HIS OWN BEAT saved ground throughout. PRAETORIAN GUARD placed in the four path leaving the midway point on the far turn, was under a drive spinning into the stretch, had no offering to give. DERVISH PRINCE guided over to the rail midway down the backstretch, was through after completing three-quarters.
