Footnotes

MY SWEET CANDY bumped with a rival at the start, was hustled to the lead, set the pace under some pressure, raced near the inside on the turn, responded well when put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, went to a strong hand ride late and was fully extended to last. BELIEVE IN BETTY was well placed just off the pace, drafted behind the pacesetter while inside on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, chased under a right-handed whip, loomed alongside MY SWEET CANDY late but couldn't get by. PHANTASTICUS bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace on the outside then three to four wide on the turn, pursued the winner into the final furlong and finished willingly to just get the show. SHOPTILLCLOSING settled on the outside of LITTLE MISS LYDIA, was urged while off the rail on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and also finished willingly but just missed the show. LADY LIZZY was bumped on both sides at the break then taken up, raced

well back in the field while urged along, went two then three wide on the turn, moved out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and improved position. STILL SHEA TO ME bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and failed to rally. LITTLE MISS LYDIA broke in and hit the gate then bobbed and bumped with LADY LIZZY, settled off the pace, was guided around the turn with left-rein pressure while along the rail and failed to threaten. DOROTHY'S SPIRIT tracked the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into upper stretch then weakened. BETTINA BRUGGE hit the gate at the start, spotted the front of the field about three to four lengths, was ridden along at the rear, raced five wide into the turn then dropped to the inside and faltered.
