TEMPER IN COMMAND broke to the outside bumping with LADY YELLOW TAIL at the start, settled into the midpack and sat reserved in the two path for just over six furlongs, was asked for some run after turning for home, waited briefly behind rivals approaching the eighth pole, gained better racing room soon afterwards and picked up the pace noticeably, took over in deep stretch and kicked clear. STRIKE ACCORD raced towards the inside in the initial stages, found space and slipped into the two path past the half mile pole, continued to bide time for the rest of the way around the far turn, was under solid encouragement angling three wide at the three-sixteenths pole, displayed a strong kick down the center of the course to garner the place. COURT OF

DREAMS raced three wide on the far turn, ranged up into contention nearing the quarter pole, got called upon and commenced to rally in earnest, battled for the lead as the widest of three from upper stretch until the sixteenth pole, got outfinished late by the top twosome, but held on well for the show. HLAO ROO sat reserved in the two path from off the front runners, picked up interest just before coming to the quarter pole, was given her cue and responded positively, fought for command from between opponents for a furlong starting to do so from the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole before weakening in the late stages. I DREAMT I WAS broke slowly, darted over to the rail and stayed there for nearly three-quarters, was on the move outward for the stretch drive, fanning five wide into upper stretch, displayed a mild response on her way to grabbing minor spoils. MANERO repositioned in her stall prior to the field being sent off and running after fidgeting about, struck the left side of the gate, then got bumped, raced from off the inside, left the five-sixteenths pole four wide, flattened out departing the furlong grounds. ALWAYSINMYCIRCLE lacked the necessary stretch response. TAKE IT INSIDE gave chase from off the inside as the only member within range of pacesetter for the opening half, issued a challenge for command late on the turn, turned for home and did battle as the innermost of three from upper to deep stretch before giving way. LADY YELLOW TAIL got bumped from between rivals at the start, swung three wide into the backstretch and continued from that path around the second turn, had no rally when called upon for the stretch drive. BONATINI bumped between rivals at the start, sat near the back of the pack, got taken outward from upper to midstretch until about eight wide by the furlong marker, failed to have an impact. MAH JONG MADDNES showed the way from the inside for just over three-quarters and faltered. SPARKS WILL FLY saved ground and tired.
