**Footnotes**

TINA'S NOTE came away in good order, set the pace under pressure while well out in the track, moved clear with a half-mile to run, entered the turn in the four path, dropped close to the two path shortly thereafter, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch while being challenged by the runner-up, was put to a right-handed whip, switched to a left-handed whip and was given one crack coming to the eighth-pole, immediately went back to the right-hand, drifted out a bit late and held determinedly. INAFASH was hard ridden on the outside, advanced five wide into the turn, dropped to near the three path before the three-eighths while chasing the leader, made a bid while four wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip, raced on even terms with the winner into the final furlong, drifted out badly when switched to a left-handed whip approaching the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to get the place. SHARON SPAGETTI chased the pace between horses, raced three wide early on the turn, dropped to the rail near the three-eighths pole, pursued the winner under a drive into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while able to secure the show. ASCENDED FEVER was ridden along while off the pace, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, advanced into a good striking position while under a drive but flattened out. GUYANA STAR was urged along towards the rear, dropped back near the half-mile pole, raced off the rail on the turn, shifted four wide late on the bend, floated six wide into upper stretch and failed to threaten. POLAN was sent hard from the start, pressed the pace between horses, dropped back while off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and tired. TOP TIER LASS chased the pace on the inside, shuffled herself back along the rail near the half-mile pole, lost position badly in the process, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. BLUE SIXTY FOUR was ridden along on the outside, lugged out a bit while five then six wide early on the turn, floated eight wide late on the bend, drifted nine to ten wide into upper stretch and faltered.
