Footnotes

FOGGY ROAD stacked in the five path approaching the half mile pole, got angled sharply over and put on to the inside route, crept up into contention steadily making his way around the bend, pilot only applying the lightest of hand urging, paused for a stride as the half was being completed before getting swung out and called upon for the drive home, scooted past STREETS OF FIRE to take charge with an eighth to go, came under attack by the runner up shortly afterwards, dug in willingly during their late duel to prove best. ONE RED CAT underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, was already under a drive spinning a bit wider into the stretch, latched on the winner past the eighth pole, inched slightly closer thereafter but had to settle for the place. KEYALY rode the rail until the five-sixteenths pole, fanned outward until in the five path by a furlong later, lacked the needed closing response to threaten the top twosome. STREETS OF FIRE moved up past MY TEDDY BEAR to take away the early advantage, vied in the two path to maintain command, had the eventual winner burst upon the scene as a danger turning for home, got called upon but got overhauled by that opponent nonetheless, backed away steadily. MY TEDDY BEAR out broke the field by a length, surrendered the front to STREETS OF FIRE soon afterward, pressed the issue parked to that rival's outside for almost a half before giving way. JACK'S LION got off to a sluggish beginning, saved ground for most of the way around the turn, [proceeded to be angled outward for the stretch, had no offering. HENGROEN broke to the outside, chased the ongoing pace dispute from the three path, was through before going a half.
