Footnotes

TIZNOWFORAMERICA away in good order, kicked away from the others quickly to establish control, without need of encouragement by the pilot, was placed along the outer border of the inside route while being rated on a loosely-contended lead, spun into the stretch without any of the competition having hitched up and got asked for a response, gave it, holding his own without loss of ground during the ensuing furlong, partially aided by the reluctance of the runner up to alter course, dug in well enough in the late stages to fend off a belated challenge and preserve the decision. HARPOON put to some encouragement by the rider leaving the starting gate, failed to make his presence during the opening stages anyway, tracked the winner while sitting a somewhat loose pocket until the quarter pole, had the top one wander closer to the rail during the initial portion of the stretch drive, was steadied momentarily before attempting to alter course to the outside, showed an unwillingness to obey the pilot's directives on the first try, was asked again in short order and after some effort by the rider cooperated this time, kicked into his best stride past the sixteenth pole, flashing good foot, but came up short. TIZAROCKET broke sharply inward taking his initial step out of the starting gate, raced from well off the inside throughout, was in the four path and being roused leaving the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match for the top twosome in the late stages. DERIVATIVECONTRACT away a beat slowly after losing his footing at the break, departed the backstretch three wide, fanned into the six path in upper stretch, got straightened away and rallied belatedly en route for the last major check. BORSEGGIATORE underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, stayed within striking distance to midlane before flattening out. YANKEE DIME chased the winner from the two path and gave way. GRIDLOCK off two beats slowly, raced along the outside, got put three wide at the head of the stretch, had no offering.
