MY SUCCESS, steadied into the first turn and steadied along inside on the backstretch, rallied in upper stretch and drew clear late under a drive. SOMETHING SLEAZY, close up inside while in hand, came wide for the drive and stayed gamely to the finish. CHLOE POND quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and stayed stubbornly to the wire. GOLD NECKLACE, rated along inside, put in a run along the inside into the stretch and finished gamely. EASTERN DANCER, rated along between rivals, had traffic problems on the second turn and finished well once clear. DANCING MERENDA raced close up while three wide and lacked a rally. D'AVENIR, carried out on the first turn, raced very wide throughout. JULIA'S CHILD raced wide and had no response when roused. BELLE'S GEMINI drifted out on the first turn, was outrun early, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. PLATINUM BABE tired after three quarters.
