MASS MEDIA raced close up outside, rallied three wide nearing the stretch, dug in determinedly in the drive and prevailed after a long battle. BATTLE WON stumbled at the start, was hustled up inside, set the pace and dug in gamely on the rail in the stretch. SILVER WAGON hit the gate at the start, was bumped, dropped back early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. YANKEE MON pressed the pace from the outside and faded in the final furlong. FOREST DANGER stumbled at the start, was bumped, was steadied along the inside on the backstretch, raced inside and tired in the stretch. KEEP THE FAITH (AUS) broke awkwardly and tired after showing brief speed.
