Footnotes

SIPSEY settled in good position just off the pace while saving ground for a half, moved out for room on the turn, split rivals while four wide entering the stretch, charged to the front in midstretch and drew clear under a vigorous hand ride. PIGGOTT stalked four wide along the backstretch, took the lead while continuing wide on the turn, relinquished the lead to the winner in midstretch and held well to clearly best the others. CURVATURE raced in midpack for a half, led a rally four wide on the turn, angled to the inside in upper stretch then rallied belatedly between horses. REGAL OFFICER was outrun for a half, saved ground while gaining on the turn, angled five wide at the three-sixteenths pole then closed late in the middle of the track. WOLLASTON BAY dueled along the rail to the top of the stretch and weakened. ROYAL WAR ACADEMY broke slowly, raced in the middle of the pack for a half, angled five wide at the quarter pole and lacked a strong closing bid. YOU'RE THE MON never reached contention after breaking slowly while racing five wide. NARTHAX raced up close along the inside, slipped through along the rail to challenge on the turn and faded in the drive. STORM SCENE broke slowly, failed to threaten while saving ground. BROOKER D pressed the pace between horses to the turn and faltered. MONT JULEPS was never a factor. SPY IN THE SKY checked at the start and was never close thereafter. BEHRENS DESIGN never reached contention.
