Footnotes

BIG BROWN opened a clear advantage in the early stages, set the pace along the inside for five furlongs, shook loose on the turn, opened a wide gap in upper stretch and was never threatened while being kept to the task under steady right hand urging. DOCTOR CAL rushed up early, stalked the pace while three wide to the turn, couldn't stay with the winner in upper stretch but continued on willingly to best the others. WOTAN was unhurried for six furlongs while four wide, launched a rally from outside on the turn, angled five wide into the stretch and closed late in the middle of the course. HIDDEN GLANCE tucked in along the rail in the early stages, lodged an inside move leaving the backstretch, closed the gap along the rail leaving the turn, took up sharply while lacking room in upper stretch, altered course to the outside in midstretch and lacked a strong closing response. INCALZANDO checked at the start, raced in the middle of the pack to the turn and lacked a rally. TRUST N DUSTAN trailed for five furlongs, checked inside midway on the turn and failed to threaten while improving his position. GLOBALIZATION pressed the pace from outside to the turn and faltered. MOTOR PATROL never reached contention while racing wide. VALADOUR steadied sharply along the rail on the far turn and was never close thereafter. WHY CAN'T I angled in early, saved ground to the turn and steadily tired thereafter.
