COUNT CATAMOUNT assumed command shortly after the start, was well rated on a loose lead, came under light urging approaching the quarter-pole, was set down while under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, braced for the challenge of ZIPTRONIC, brushed with that rival outside the sixteenth-pole and held gamely. BOLD VINDICATION hit the gate at the start, settled on the inside, was asked to move closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced inside while under light urging on the far turn, moved out and was roused in upper stretch, gathered momentum into the final furlong and closed fast late but just missed. ZIPTRONIC bumped with SEPARATIST at the start, stalked the leader on the outside, was asked to go after that rival nearing the quarter-pole, drifted in a bit under right hand urging once straightened for the drive, loomed alongside COUNT CATAMOUNT, battled with that rival while under strong right hand urging, brushed with the aforementioned rival outside the sixteenth-pole and couldn't get by then missed the place. TRIPP O STEEL was taken in hand early, raced with his mouth wide open while under a very tight hold, resisted the strangle hold used by his rider near the five-eighths pole, continued under a tight hold, resisted the strangle hold again with three furlongs to run, was finally given his head while between rivals into the stretch, came under

strong urging near the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed kick in an uncomfortable journey. INDY SCENT dropped back after the start then angled in, raced off the hedge on the first turn, was reserved near the back of the field, lacked room against the hedge midway through the far turn, passed rivals while inside into upper stretch and finished willingly. BRITISH BANKER raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field under some restraint, was asked while off the hedge midway through the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, moved between rivals in the vicinity of the furlong marker and failed to threaten. MONTANA KNIGHT went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and failed to respond. WORTHY WAGER raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch then weakened. SEPARATIST bumped with ZIPTRONIC at the start, settled in the middle of the field while a bit off the hedge, was roused outside the quarter-pole and also failed to respond. (Rail at Hedge)
