**Footnotes**

HAVRE DE GRACE sat patiently in the four path making her way around the first turn, found room and was guided closer to the inside entering the backstretch, sat perched three wide down the backstretch, staying within range of the pacesetter, was released from a firm hold at the half mile pole, gradually closed in on RULE during the run around the far turn, turned for home in hot pursuit at a slight distance behind and got called upon, dueled with the previously mentioned opponent, cutting into that's margin, was barely a head shy of the front as that pair struck the eighth pole, forged her way to the lead soon afterwards and edged away under good handling. FLAT OUT three wide around each bend, sat reserved for the opening three-quarters, was let out a notch and instantly picked up interest, moving up into a good striking position by the quarter pole, came home with good energy during the stretch run to garner place honors. RULE broke on top, quickly established control and was angled over to the inside, was lightly coaxed setting the splits, left the backstretch under slightly more energetic handling, felt the presence of the top one coming to the five-sixteenths pole and was put to vigorous hand encouragement in response, fought hard only to have his edge dwindle down bit by bit from the head of the stretch to the furlong marker, relinquished to the winner's intense pressure shortly after departing the furlong grounds, eventually weakening into the show slot. MISSION IMPAZIBLE prompted the pacesetter from the two path for six furlongs before backing away. GIANT OAK off the inside, lacked the needed response. ICE BOX lagged behind, swung four wide into upper stretch, failed to menace. MAMBO MEISTER underwent a three to four wide journey and folded. CONVOCATION hung out in the three path between rivals on the opening turn, tucked along the rail early on the backstretch, saved ground and faded.
