ZA APPROVAL put to a firm hold leaving the starting gate, rated kindly, contently stalked the ongoing speed duel from the two path, continued to do so for nearly three-quarters, was guided into the three path at the five-sixteenths pole and moved up to confront the two front runners, was asked for a response entering the stretch and overhauled that pair to take charge during the run through the furlong grounds, dug in well to hold sway. GRIGIO rode the hedge, lightly coaxed along to stay within range and to maintain interest, availed of the opportunity to ease outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home a slight distance off the leaders, waited until the three-sixteenths pole before being given his cue, closed with good energy but had to settle for place honors. MAGNIFICENT MOON saved ground, angled five wide into the stretch before commencing to rally in earnest, continued on willingly en route for the show. LOVE OF FLYING raced towards the inside, was let out a notch departing the backstretch, was taken outward midpoint on the far turn, moved past a tiring KING HAIGLER and ducked back to the inside at the three-sixteenths pole, advanced steadily during the remainder of the run through the furlong grounds, sat placed just off the top one's hind quarters with an eighth to go, but could not sustain the bid. IMAGING three wide on the far turn, was placed six wide at the head of the stretch, rallied mildly to improve position. STAR OF ESCONDIDA reserved off the hedge, entered the second turn three wide, was put in the four path by the five-sixteenths pole prior to taking a run at the front runners, made an abbreviated bid approaching the top of the stretch

before backing away. MCCARROLL broke running and went on to contest the pace with KING HAIGLER, raced as a team, heads apart, through lively opening splits, felt pressure from the eventual winner to his outside late on the far turn and gave way. BLUEGRASS SUMMER took the inside route, was urged on the second turn but failed to reach a contending position. BELUSHI along the inside, steadied in tight quarters pole beginning the run around the opening bend, was no factor. MAJESTIC MAN well placed in the pocket off a disputed pace, faded. KING HAIGLER argued for the lead while racing along the inside until the quarter pole, gave way. STOLEN GLANCE raced along the outside and was outrun.
