Footnotes

NOBLE TUNE made contact with the left side of the starting gate, took up position in the middle of the field and rode the rail for nearly three-quarters, found ample space between the pair directly in front leaving the midway point on the far turn and was eased into it, paused for two jumps under a good hold prior to the quarter pole, spun into the lane with clear passage awaiting, the former pacesetter having drifted three wide turning for home, was given his cue and responded positively, splitting rivals at the three-sixteenths marker to take charge, arrived at the eighth pole with none latched on, but with a firing line of four potentially poised to strike, kicked well clear of them all under good handling. DRAW TWO swung three wide into the backstretch, remained well off the inside throughout, commenced the stretch drive five wide and came home with good energy to procure the place. METRO three wide around both turns, was roused in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, got outfinished. CHANNEL ISLE forwardly placed while just off the rail, tucked along the inside for good just past the half mile pole, was put to a drive a furlong down the road, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away. NEWFOUND ZAPPER prompted the pacesetter from the outside for six furlongs and folded. LEVERAGED LOAN three wide for the opening three-quarters, was placed one path wider late on the second turn, had no rally. BYE BYE BERNIE took an awkward first step leaving the starting gate, sprinted to the front, was guided over to the inside, showed the way, under a good hold by the rider and with head bowed down slightly, came under intensified pressure during the later stages of the run around the far turn, drifted three wide into the stretch and gave way. NEVER THE END brushed the left side of the gate, sat reserved near the rear of the pack, angled outward into the stretch until about six wide by the three-sixteenths pole, lacked a kick. SO OUTSPOKEN between rivals on the opening bend, was through before going six furlongs. DOMINATE faded off a ground-saving journey.
